The After School Program is proud to provide students with the opportunity of taking quality private music lessons right here at school! We have a variety of experienced music instructors available throughout the week. Emerson's Band and Orchestra programs are a great way to make music with others! Orchestra begins in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, meets after school, and is run by Leslie Capozzoli (<a href="leapozzoli@emerson-school.org">leapozzoli@emerson-school.org</a>). Band begins in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, meets before school, and is run by Michelle Borton (<a href="majority">mborton@emerson-school.org</a>). Participation in both Band and Orchestra requires weekly private lessons.

Each thirty minute lesson costs \$30 and will be billed to your account at the end of each month. Students will not be billed childcare rates *during* their lesson; you will be billed for the total amount of time spent in childcare *outside* of the 30-minute lesson. Be sure to sign your child using your PIN the library each day.

Lessons are available to students currently enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. You are responsible for providing your own instrument and purchasing music books throughout the school year for your child. Your child's music instructor will help guide you in what to purchase and when. Please help your child to remember to bring his/her music to the lessons, along with a spiral notebook for writing down assignments and instructions.

Your child needs to practice his/her instrument regularly. A typical amount of practice for a child in the elementary grades is 15-20 minutes a day, 6 days a week. It is much more useful to spread one's practicing over several days than to do it all at once. Lessons are a year-long commitment. They begin the week of September 21<sup>st</sup> and continue through the end of May.

Notice for planned absences must be given to Beth Muszkiewicz at least *one week* prior to the lesson date to be missed. You will not be charged for missed lessons in the event of the student's absence from school due to illness, music teacher's absence, or school closings. You will be charged for the lesson in the event that a

student (or parent) forgets about the lesson, forgets her/his instrument, or fails to provide notice of absence one week in advance.
