OVERVIEW

Fall Enrichment Classes will begin the week of Monday, September 16th and end the week of Monday, October 28th. <u>There will be no classes during the week of Monday</u>, October 14th due to <u>Parent-Teacher Conferences</u>. These classes are open to all Emerson students. All classes will take place during after school hours, each class meeting once a week for 1 hour or 1.5 hours and beginning no earlier than 3:00pm. All of our enrichment courses are taught by Emerson teachers, parents, and some <u>Summer at Emerson</u> and After School Program staff members.

REGISTRATION

All families who wish to register for an enrichment class must sign up via our <u>SignUp Genius link</u>. Grade level requirements are firmly set for each class and will not be modified. CANCELLATION POLICY

If a weekly class meeting is canceled for any reason (instructor absence, weather, etc), we will do our best to schedule a make-up date. This make-up meeting would occur on the same day and time that the class normally would meet during a given week. This rescheduling will depend on the school calendar and the instructor's availability. If a make-up meeting is not possible, we will prorate the total cost of the class at the end of the session to account for the missed class meeting.

PAYMENT

Our regular class prices range from \$169 to \$332, as noted in the class descriptions. Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment will be canceled; you will be notified via email and your account will not be charged. Each class fee covers all associated costs and will be billed to your account at the end of November. *Refunds are not given for missed classes or mid-session withdrawals*.
